FINAL ORDER

FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 3rd day of June, 1994, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") sitting as a whole the request for extension or renewal of institutional license number 8-00239 filed by Chi Wha Chung, M.D. (hereinafter "Licensee").

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appeared before and on behalf of the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the request and the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. K.S.A. 65-2895 provides that an institutional license may be issued by the Board and sets forth the criteria under which said license may be issued.

2. K.S.A. 65-2895(b) provides that an institutional license shall be valid for a period of two years after the date of issuance and may be renewed if the applicant meets the requirements set forth in said subsection.

3. On August 3, 1992, Licensee received institutional license number 8-00239 which will expire August 3, 1994 pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2895(b).

4. This matter originally came before the Board at its meeting of April 16, 1994 and was continued to this date to enable Licensee to provide any additional information indicating the Board has the statutory authority to either extend or renew the institutional license.

5. Licensee has not successfully completed the examination required under subsection (a)(3) of 65-2873 as required by K.S.A. 65-2895(b) so as to enable the institutional license issued to her August 3, 1992 to be renewed under the provisions of that subsection.

6. That Licensee's institutional license number 8-00239 which will expire August 3, 1994 should be cancelled in accordance with the proceedings under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act following the date of expiration due to the fact that Licensee is not eligible for renewal or extension of said license pursuant to the appropriate statutory provisions as above cited.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED:

a) That the findings here and above made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board.

b) That institutional license number 8-00239 originally issued August 3, 1992 and which will expire August 3, 1994 should be cancelled from and after the expiration date thereof and thereafter be of no further force and effect.

c) That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
