FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING REQUIREMENTS

NOW on this 12th day of April 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Maureen S. Clark, O.T. (“Licensee”) for termination of the monitoring requirements set forth in Consent Order. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane E. Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-5401 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and orders:

1. Licensee is presently licensed to engage in the practice of occupational therapy in the State of Kansas, License No. 17-02101, and has been so licensed since approximately February 23, 2010.
2. On or about February 23, 2010, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted reinstatement of licensure in order to resolve concerns

4. The monitoring requirements were not self-terminating. The terms of the Consent Order allow Licensee to request the Board for modification or termination of the requirements after a three (3) year monitoring period.


5. Reports concerning Licensee's compliance Confidential were submitted to the Board, all of which indicated Licensee was in satisfactory compliance with all requirements of the program.

6. On or about January 23, 2013, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order.

7. Upon review of the evidence presented, the Board determined that Licensee has satisfactorily met all monitoring requirements of the Consent Order sufficient to warrant termination, and has no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, that Licensee's request to terminate the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order is hereby granted.


