

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 7th day of December, 1985, by and between the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, hereinafter referred to as "Board" and Robert Thomas Clark, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee".

WITNESSES:

WHEREAS, on or about September 13th, 1985, the Board received the Disciplinary Action Report issued by the Federation of State Medical Boards for the month of August 1985, indicating Licensee had been issued a license under conditions by the Georgia Composite Board of Medical Examiners on August 7, 1985.

WHEREAS, based upon the aforementioned, the Disciplinary Counsel for the Board obtained various documents which served as a basis for the action taken by the Georgia Medical Board and,

WHEREAS, the action taken by the State of Georgia may constitute grounds to have Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas revoked, suspended or limited, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter into this stipulation in lieu of proceeding with any further investigations, reviews and/or disciplinary proceedings as defined by the statutes of the State of Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of any further investigations, reviews and/or disciplinary proceedings and the other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Board agrees to take no disciplinary action against the Licensee based upon the aforementioned action taken by the Georgia Medical Board until such time as Licensee has advised the Board, as hereinafter indicated, that he desires to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

2. That Licensee agrees to give to the Board at least ninety (90) days notice prior to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

3. That Licensee waives a speedy determination of this matter and agrees that the Board may undertake such further investigation, review and institute such proceedings as it deems appropriate regarding Licensee's medical and surgical abilities at such time as Licensee has notified the Board that he desires to actively engage in the practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

4. The conditions herein set forth are to be strictly construed and adhered to. Should Licensee engage in the active practice of medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas without first providing the Board with the required notice as

herein above stated, the Board may institute formal proceedings against Licensee for the revocation, suspension or limitation of the license of Licensee to practice medicine and surgery within the State of Kansas.

5. This stipulation shall remain in force and effect until it is modified by written agreement by and between both parties.
