FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 12th day of June, 1993, this matter comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"), sitting as a whole, pursuant to a request for a license to practice medicine and surgery filed by Robert T. Clark, M.D., (hereinafter "Petitioner").

Petitioner did not appear. Debra L. Billingsley, Disciplinary Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board.

After reviewing the request of the Petitioner and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follow:

- 1. K.S.A. 65-2836 provides that an application for a license may be denied upon a finding of the existence of the grounds listed in 65-2836 and 65-2837.
- 2. K.S.A. 65-2836(j) provides that a license application may be denied if the Petitioner has had a license to practice the Healing Arts revoked, suspended or limited, has been censured or has had other disciplinary action taken, or an application for a license denied, by the proper licensing authority of another state, territory, District of Columbia, or other

country.

- On May 5, 1993, the Board received a Certified Copy of an Order and Verification of License showing that Petitioner's Arkansas license number C-4461 was on a suspended status.
- 4. Therefore, Petitioner's application request hereby denied based on the suspension of licensure from state of Arkansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2836(j).

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED:

- The findings hereinabove may be and the same a) are hereby made the Order of the Board.
- That Petitioner's application request b) licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas be denied based on the suspension of licensure in Arkansas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service by mail to the party's last known address. Any party may, within 15 days of service, file a petition for reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
