FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING

NOW on this 9th day of October, 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Charlie Collenborne, M.D. ("Licensee") for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed on April 19, 2011. Licensee appears in person and *through counsel* Ivery Goldstein of Simpson, Logback, Lynch, Norris, P.A. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. On July 9, 2015, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of the monitoring provisions contained in the Consent Order.
- 2. On September 10, 2015, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring.
- 3. On September 23, 2015, Petitioner filed a Reply to Board's Response Motion to Terminate Consent Order.

4. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and concludes that termination of the monitoring requirement is warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF
HEALING ARTS that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed on
April 19, 2011, is hereby TERMINATED and that Licensee shall have no further obligation for
compliance.
