FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 12th day of March, 1994, this matter comes on for Conference Hearing on the application of William J. Conrad (hereafter "Applicant") for registration as a physician's assistant.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of fact and order:

1) On February 5, 1994, Applicant filed an application for registration as a physician's assistant.

2) K.S.A. 65-2896(a)(2) provides that a person who desires to have their name entered on the register of physicians' assistants must have presented to the Board proof that the Applicant has successfully completed a course of education and training approved by the Board for the education and training of physician's assistants or presented proof that the applicant has acquired experience while serving in the armed forces of the United States which experience is equivalent to certain minimum requirements established by the Board.

3) Applicant served in the United States Navy from 1968-1971 and received training as an operating room technician and received cross training in various medical fields.

4) Applicant passed the approved examination for physicians' assistants in 1978 and has been registered as a physician's assistant in the State of Colorado since February 2, 1984.

5) A majority of the members of the physician's assistant council have reviewed Applicant's application and have recommended that Applicant be registered as a physician's assistant.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that Applicant possesses equivalent qualifications based on training and experience to be registered as a physician's assistant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a final order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
