SUMMARY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 2 day of May, 2009, this matter comes before John (Jack) Confer, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537.

After reviewing the agency record and being duly advised in the premises, the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order are made for and on behalf of the Board:

- 1. Sonja M Cornley, PA ("Licensee") was originally issued license number 15-01115 to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas on August 12, 2006, pursuant to K.A.R. 100-28a-15.
- 2. K.A.R. 100-28a-5 requires each Licensee desiring to renew a Physician Assistant license to submit to the Board documented evidence of completion of a minimum of 50 contact hours of continuing education with a minimum of 20 hours of category I and a maximum of 30 hours of category II since January 1, 2008, or 100 contact hours of continuing education with a minimum of 40 hours of category I and a maximum of 60 hours of category II since January 1, 2007, before or with the request for renewal.
- 3. On or about December 31, 2008, Licensee submitted an application for renewal of their license.

- 4. As part of the renewal process, Licensee certified that the rules regarding proof of continuing education had been read, that 100 hours of continuing education hours had been achieved, and that documentation of those hours would be maintained for a three-year period and produced to the Board upon request.
- 5. As part of the renewal process, Licensee further certified that the notice regarding the Board's procedures for auditing continuing education compliance had been read.
- 6. Licensee was randomly selected to provide verification of compliance with the continuing education requirements and on February 20, 2009, a letter was mailed to Licensee requesting that Licensee provide no later than March 31, 2009, the records relied upon when Licensee certified achievement of the required continuing education hours.
- 7. A second letter requesting proof of continuing education by May 11, 209 was sent to becease on April 22, 2009 by certified mail through the United States Postal Service.
 - 8. The second request letter was signed for by the licensee on April 25, 2009.
- 9. Licensee failed to provide documented evidence of continuing education by the due date.
- 10. By failing to provide documented evidence of her continuing education, Licensee has violated K.S.A. 65-2836(r), failing to respond to the Board's legal request for information.
- IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that you shall submit proof that you have met your continuing education requirements for the previous year to the Board within fifteen days.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. A request for a
