EX PARTE SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 19th day of October, 1991, comes on for summary hearing the request of Jeff F. Crist, R.P.T. (hereafter "Registrant") for written consent to supervise four physical therapist assistants as required by K.A.R. 100-46-3.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of fact and order:

1. Registrant filed a request to supervise four (4) physical therapist assistants on October 16, 1991.
2. Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-46-3, a physical therapist shall not have more than three physical therapist assistants working under the direction of the physical therapist at any time, except with the written consent of the Board.
3. Registrant should be provided with the approval and consent of the Board to continue to supervise four (4) physical therapist assistants to end April 19, 1992.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Registrant is authorized to supervise four (4) physical therapist assistants currently under his supervision to end April 19, 1992.



within 15 days of service of this Order and if a hearing is not requested within the time and manner stated above, this decision becomes final and effective upon the expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.
