SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 8th day of April 2006, comes on for summary proceedings before the Kansas State Board of Healing ("Board") the Application for Licensure as a Respiratory Therapist filed by Virginia M. Cronister, RT ("Applicant"). Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing the presentation made by Ms. Abbott, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

- 1. On January 24, 2006, Applicant filed an Application for Licensure as a Respiratory Therapist in the state of Kansas.
- 2. As part of the Application, Applicant provided notarized information that she graduated from Mt. Carmel Medical Center School of Medical and Respiratory Technology in 1974.
- 3. Applicant has been unable to locate a copy of her diploma in respiratory technology and, because the school of respiratory technology at Mt Carmel has been closed for a number of years and its records are no longer available, Applicant cannot provide a copy of her transcripts.

4. Applicant has a current and active license to practice respiratory therapy in

the state of Missouri and has previously been issued a license in Arkansas which is on

inactive status.

5. Applicant's credentials have been reviewed by the Respiratory Care

Council and the Council has recommended that the Board waive the requirements that

Applicant provide a copy of her diploma and transcripts.

6. For good cause shown, Applicant's request for waiver of the requirements

of transcript and diploma should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for waiver of the

requirements that she provide transcripts and diploma from her respiratory care program

is granted.

summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following

service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall

become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a
