FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 23rd day of February, 2002, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts, (hereafter "Board") the request submitted by Dean S. Cunningham, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") to withdraw his application to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On or about November 15, 2001, Applicant filed an application for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
- 2. Applicant disclosed in his application that he has had seven medical liability claims settled against him for acts which occurred from 1993 through 1998 regarding his care of patients.
- 3. On January 29, 2002, Ms. Benintendi, at the direction of the Board's Disciplinary Panel, filed an Answer in Opposition to Application for License to Practice Medicine and Surgery due to allegations involving acts of negligent treatment to patients and which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action under the Healing Arts Act.
- 4. Notice of a Conference Hearing on Applicant's application for licensure was set for 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, February 23, 2002 and filed herein on February 1, 2002.
 - 5. On February 5, 2002, by correspondence to Ms. Benintendi, Applicant requested to

withdraw his application for licensure.

6. Notice of Conference Hearing on Applicant's request to withdraw his application for

licensure was set for 10:45 a.m. on Saturday, February 23, 2002 and filed herein on February 5,

2002.

7. At the Conference Hearing held on February 23, 2002, after reviewing the file and being

otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds that Applicant's request to withdraw his

application for licensure should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

That Applicant's request to withdraw his application to practice medicine and surgery in the

state of Kansas has been voluntarily withdrawn and no further proceedings are required or necessary.
