**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW on this 12th day of June, 1992, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the application of Guy Santos da Silva, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for license to practice medicine and surgery by endorsement.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, and order:

1. Applicant has heretofore filed an application for endorsement to receive a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.

2. K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2873 provides that a person can not be licensed under that statute unless the school from which they graduated has been in existence for more than fifteen (15) years.

3. In the application filed herein, Applicant indicated and provided evidence that he is a graduate of Spartan Health Sciences University in the Dominican Republic.

4. According to the World Health Organization Directory, Spartan Health Sciences University commenced instruction in 1980.

5. According to the information provided by Applicant, Applicant has been licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the states of Pennsylvania and New York.

6. Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2833, Applicant meets the requirements to receive a license by endorsement based upon the licenses issued to him by the states of New York and Pennsylvania.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that Applicant meets the requirements of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2833 to receive a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas by endorsement based upon the New York and Pennsylvania licenses previously issued to him.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
