JOURNAL ENTRY ON MODIFICATION OF CONSENT ORDER

On August 10, 2018, Jenni A. Denton, O.T.A. (“Applicant”) and Associate Litigation Counsel Courtney E. Manly appeared before the Board for a conference hearing. The parties submitted a proposed Consent Order, executed by Applicant on July 2, 2018, for the Board’s review and approval. The Board heard statements from Associate Litigation Counsel and testimony from Applicant. Upon review of the proposed consent order, and taking into consideration of the statements and testimony received at the hearing, the Board determined that the monitoring requirement contained in the proposed consent order should be removed. This revision was discussed with the parties at the hearing, and there were no objections.

Therefore, the Board **ORDERS** that the consent order that was executed by Licensee on July 2, 2018, submitted to the Board for review and approval at the August 10, 2018 Board meeting, and subsequently signed by the Executive Director and filed in this matter, is hereby modified to delete the requirement that Licensee submit to three years of monitoring. Therefore, paragraphs 56, 57, 59, 60, 62, and 63 are deleted and vacated. Paragraph 68 is modified to delete and vacate the following: “, and recommendations and monitoring [REDACTED]” The remainder of the consent order remains in effect.
