**ORDER DENYING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT**

NOW on this 14th day of October, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Tammy DeShazer (hereafter "Permittee") to grant a third temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 65-2906(b)(3) and more specifically, K.A.R. 100-36-1.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Permittee appears in person *pro se*. Jackie Rawlins appears on behalf of the Physical Therapy Examining Committee.

After hearing statements from the parties and Permittee and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

- 1) A request for a third temporary permit was submitted by Permittee on September 24, 1995, and conference hearing was set for October 14, 1995 at 8:45 a.m.
- 2) Permittee has applied for permanent registration as a physical therapist assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 65-2906(b)(3).

3) Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1, not more than two temporary permits shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board and for which good cause shall be shown.

4) The Board finds that insufficient cause exists to grant Permittee a third temporary permit. Permittee may reapply for a third temporary permit once she has passed the required exam, has provided proof as such, and has met all of the requirements for permanent certification as a physical therapy assistant.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

- a. That Permittee's request for a third temporary permit is denied.
- b. That this is a final order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
