FINAL ORDER

NOW this April 16, 2010 the above captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (Board) on the petitioner's Motion to Reconsider the Final Order entered by the Board on August 14, 2009. The respondent appears by and through Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel. The petitioner, Frederick Dopps, D.C. appears in person pro se. There are no other appearances. The Board, being familiar with the file, after hearing the statements of counsel, after hearing the sworn testimony of the respondent and being duly apprised of the premises finds and concludes as follow:

WHEREUPON, the Board heard the respondent's MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION of the BOARD'S FINAL ORDER:

1. The disciplinary panel consisting of Dr. Counselman, Dr. Templeton, and Dr. Leinwetter recuse themselves.
2. There are no material issues of fact.
3. On August 14, 2009, the Board ordered the respondent to complete the Special Purpose Examination for Chiropractic (SPEC) before August, 2010.
4. The petitioner requests the Board reconsider its August, 2009 order requiring him to take the SPEC exam before August, 2010 and grant him a license to practice chiropractic.
5. The Board denies the respondent's MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION. The Board upholds the Board's FINAL ORDER of August, 2009.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon Kathleen Selzler Lippert, the Board's Interim Executive Director, at 235 SW Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.


