FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 11th day of February, 2006, this matter comes on for hearing.

Respondent Walter Dorfner appears *pro se*. Kathleen Lippert, Associate Counsel appears for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The material facts are not disputed. **(Confidential)**

2. In the course of its investigation the Board requested that Respondent provide additional information. The first request was made on October 31, 2005. Additional requests were made November 21, and December 19. Respondent did not respond to any of these requests.

3. Respondent acknowledges that he should have responded to the requests.

4. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 65-5510(a)(2) provides that a license may be subject to a disciplinary order for committing an act of unprofessional conduct, as that term is

defined by Board regulations. K.A.R. 100-55-5(h) defines unprofessional conduct to include the failure to furnish the Board or its investigators or representatives any information that is legally requested.

5. The Board finds and concludes that Respondent has engaged in unprofessional conduct. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 65-5510(c) authorizes the Board to issue a fine against a licensee who has been found to have engaged in unprofessional conduct.


