FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 15th day of February, 2003, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts, (hereafter “Board”) the request submitted by Lawrence E. Dorman, D.O. (hereafter “Applicant”) to withdraw his application for reinstatement of license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board. Licensee did not appear.

After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On or about July 16, 2002, Applicant submitted an application for reinstatement of a license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. Applicant disclosed in his application that the Missouri Board of Registration for the Healing Arts revoked his license in October of 1999.
3. On November 13, 2002, Ms. Benintendi, at the direction of the Board’s Disciplinary Panel, filed a Response in Opposition to Application for Reinstatement of License to Practice Medicine and Surgery for allegations involving repeated acts of negligence regarding patient care and allegations involving violation of a board stipulation. Both types of alleged violations are grounds for disciplinary action under the Healing Arts Act.
4. Notice of a Conference Hearing on Applicant’s application for reinstatement was mailed

to Applicant and the matter was set for Saturday, December 14, 2002 at 2:00 p.m. The Board continued the matter to the February Board meeting.

5. By correspondence dated December 16, 2002, counsel for Applicant notified the Board that Dr. Dorman requested to withdraw his pending application for reinstatement of license.


6. On December 31, 2002, an Amended Notice of Conference Hearing was mailed to Applicant regarding his request to withdraw his application for reinstatement. The matter was set for Saturday, February 15, 2003 at 9:00 a.m.

7. At the Conference Hearing held on February 15, 2003, after reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds that Applicant's request to withdraw his application for reinstatement of license should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Applicant's request to withdraw his application for reinstatement of license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas has been voluntarily withdrawn and no further proceedings are required or necessary.
