## FINAL ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY LICENSE

**NOW** on this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Michael A. Dorsch, P.A. ('Licensee") for an extension of his temporary license to practice as a physician assistant in Kansas. Licensee appears *pro se* via telephone.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Physician Assistant Licensure Act, K.S.A. 65-28a01, et seq., and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the Licensee, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

- 1. On or about August 2, 2011, Licensee submitted an application for licensure to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas.
- 2. On or about August 24, 2011, Licensee was granted a one-year temporary license pursuant to K.S.A. 65-28a07 pending his passage of the physician assistant certifying examination.
- 3. Despite multiple attempts which resulted in improving scores, Licensee has not yet passed the physician assistant certifying examination.

4. Licensee is eligible to retake the examination after December 17, 2012, and

intends to do so shortly thereafter.

5. Licensee requests an extension of his temporary license pursuant to K.S.A. 65-

28a07(b)(2).

6. In contemplating Licensee's request, the Board considered the statement of

Licensee's supervising physician which indicates that Licensee has strong clinical knowledge

and skills. The Board also considered Licensee's above average grades in obtaining his

Physician Assistant degree, Licensee's testimony about his difficulty in taking computerized

tests, and Licensee's testimony about his past and future study methods to prepare for taking the

examination.

7. A majority of the Board finds that based on Licensee's individual qualifications

and circumstances, an extension of his temporary license through February 11, 2013, is

warranted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF

HEALING ARTS that Licensee's temporary license to practice as a physician assistant in the

State of Kansas is hereby extended through February 11, 2013.
