## JOURNAL ENTRY TERMINATING SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., as amended, and upon due consideration of the file and applicable statutes and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. Richard K. Dyer, M.D. ("Licensee") was previously licensed to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, having applied for and been issued License No. 04-30539 on or about April 17, 2004.
2. Licensee's last known mailing address provided to the board is: confidential confidential Manhattan, Kansas 66503.
3. On or about July 1, 2008, Licensee's license was canceled for failure to renew.
4. On or about April 28, 2011, Licensee filed an application for renewal of licensure with a request for federally active designation.
5. On such application, Licensee misrepresented that he had never been arrested or convicted of a crime, and further that he had never had any complaints filed against him with a licensing agency.
6. On July 8, 2011, in accordance with K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-514, and as authorized by K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 65-2836, the Board issued a Final Order Granting Reinstatement of Licensure Subject to Discipline which included discipline in the form of a suspension of Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas for a period of thirty (30) days and a fine in the amount of $\$ 500.00$.
7. Pursuant to such Final Order, the suspension of Licensee's license was to automatically terminate on August 7, 2011.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the suspension of Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is hereby terminated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board shall maintain jurisdiction over this matter to issue any further Order(s) deemed necessary and appropriate.
