JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On March 21, 2019 the Board issued a Summary Order imposing the requirements therein.
2. The Summary Order, upon effectiveness as a Final Order, would indefinitely suspend Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas until either Licensee changed her status from Active to Inactive or Exempt, or until such time she obtained and maintained a policy of professional liability insurance as required by K.S.A. 40-3402 and 40-3403a and provides proof of payment of premium surcharges required under K.S.A. 40-3404.
3. Licensee complied with the above stated requirement before the Summary Order became effective as a Final Order. Therefore, Licensee's license was not suspended at any time.
4. The Board has received evidence of compliance with all other requirements of the Summary Order.
5. Licensee has no further obligation for compliance with the Summary Order.


