**ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY REGISTRATION**

NOW on this 14th day of October, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board pursuant to K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, at the request of Rajab Tongwa Echessa (hereinafter "Applicant") to grant a third temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). Applicant appears in person *pro se*. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for third temporary registration was received from Rajab Echessa on September 4, 1995.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 8:45 a.m. on October 14, 1995 was filed herein on September 29, 1995 and served on Applicant on that same date.

3. Applicant has applied for permanent registration as an occupational therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406(a)(3).

4. Applicant was granted temporary registration number 9501962, which expires October 14, 1995.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that good cause exists to grant Applicant a third temporary permit until the results of the OTR exam become available.

7. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a third temporary registration.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary registration be granted to Applicant until the Board receives the results from the OTR examination.

B. That in the event Applicant fails to pass the OTR examination, the third temporary registration hereby granted to Applicant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following the date the failure of said exam becomes available to the Board.

C. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
