3. The petitioner's motion for admission to practice as an M.D. by endorsement is GRANTED.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner is GRANTED a license to practice as an M.D. in Kansas.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order
