## FINAL ORDER REVOKING LICENSURE

NOW on this $12^{\text {th }}$ day of August 2011, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Board's Petition against Derek Ensz, LRT ("Licensee") seeking revocation of licensure. Licensee appeared by and through his counsel, Mike Francis. Lori Dougherty, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Petitioner Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-7301 et seq. and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of both counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

## I. Findings

1. Derek Ensz, LRT ("Licensee"), is presently licensed to engage in the practice of radiologic technology in the State of Kansas, License No. 22-03909, and has been so licensed since being granted a license on approximately April 15, 2011.
2. Licensee's last known mailing address provided to the Board is: 3312 Homestead, Hutchinson, Kansas 67502.
3. On or about October 4, 2010, Licensee submitted an application for licensure to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on January 6, 2011.

[^0]4. On or about April 19, 2011, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board confidential

Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Board granted Licensee's application for a license to practice as a radiologic technologist in the State of Kansas.

6. Licensee knowingly agreed to the terms of the Consent Order as a condition of being granted licensure in Kansas.

## II. Conclusions

7. Licensee is guilty of fraud or deceit in the procurement of a license.
8. Licensee's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation of licensure pursuant to K.S.A. 65-7313(a)(1).

## III. Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee's license to practice as a radiologic technologist in Kansas is hereby REVOKED.
