FINAL ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER

NOW on this 10th day of June, 2016, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the request of Greg Epperson, M.D. (“Licensee”) for termination of the Amendment to the Consent Order filed on February 26, 2015. Licensee appears in person and *through counsel*, Mark Stafford of Simpson, Logback, Lynch, Norris, P.A. Susan Gering, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving evidence, and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:


1. On February 26, 2015, Licensee entered into an Amendment to the August 20, 2012 Consent Order. It required Licensee to have an approved educational preceptor at each practice location for the length of one (1) year; it also required Licensee to pay Board Costs.
2. Licensee made his final payment on December 23, 2015.
3. On March 7, 2016, Licensee submitted a request to the Board for termination of Amendment to the Consent Order and the Amendment of the Consent Order in full.

4. On April 22, 2016, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Request to Terminate Monitoring.

5. The Board finds that the Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Amendment to the Consent Order and concludes that termination is warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the Amendment to the Consent Order filed on February 26, 2015, is hereby **TERMINATED** and that the Licensee shall have no further obligation for compliance.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service, and service of a Final Order is complete upon mailing. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
