NOW on this 7 day of June 2011, this matter comes before Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Executive Director, Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), regarding Licensee's satisfaction of all the requirements contained in the Consent Order.

Wherefore, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On or about April 19, 2011, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board. The Consent Order included public censure for violating the Healing Acts Act requiring Licensee pay a fine in the amount of \$500.00, which was due and payable by April 30, 2011.
2. Further, the Consent Order required Licensee to perform a thorough review of and write a paper summarizing either the AAOS Standards of Professionalism regarding advertising or the published advertising standards of AOBOS, and submit the same to the Board on or before March 31, 2011.
3. On or about April 18, 2011, Licensee paid the \$500.00 fine in full.
4. On or about April 15, 2011, Licensee provided the Board with proof of completion of his thorough review of the Principles of Medical Ethics and Professionalism in Orthopaedic Surgery, as adopted by the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, in their Standards of Professionalism on Advertising by Orthopaedic Surgeons, by submitting to the Board his written summary of the same.


5. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.


