FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 20th day of October, 2007, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas filed by Wendy Lyn C. Estrellado, M.D. (“Applicant”). Katy Lenahan, Licensing Administrator, provided information to the Board. Applicant appeared in person *pro se*.

After reviewing the file, hearing the information provided by Ms. Lenahan, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings and orders.

1. On or about June 8, 2007, Applicant filed an Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. Information provided as part of the application indicates that Applicant passed Step 1 of USMLE on September 21, 1993, Step 2(CK) on March 30, 1993, Step 2(CS) on December 12, 2005 and Step 3 on August 2, 2006.
3. Applicant practiced and obtained postgraduate training in the Philippines from 1992 through June 2002.

4. From July 1, 2002 through July 2005, Applicant obtained additional postgraduate training in the United States and during such period had permits to practice issued by the states of Florida and Illinois.

5. Applicant did not pass Step 2(CS) and Step 3 of USMLE within the time limit established by K.A.R. 100-7-1(b)(1).

6. Applicant holds permanent and unrestricted licenses in the states of Pennsylvania and Missouri.


7.. Although Applicant did not pass Step 2(CS) and Step 3 of USMLE within 10 years of passage of Step 1, Applicant meets the requirements of K.S.A.65-2833 for endorsement based upon her licensure in Pennsylvania and Missouri and passage of all steps of USMLE, which are the examinations required in this state.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant is eligible for license by endorsement based upon her Pennsylvania and Missouri licenses and her Application for Licensure should be granted effective October 20, 2007.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.


