

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2896d, not more than one Temporary Registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. Upon payment of the appropriate fee, Registrant should be granted a Second Temporary Registration until the Board results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1992 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, upon payment of the appropriate fee, a Second Temporary Registration be granted to Barbra Falta until the Board receives results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1992 become available.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Registrant fails to pass the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1992, the Second Temporary Registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date the failure becomes available to the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
