ORDER OF DENIAL OF LICENSE

NOW on this 20th day of December, 1989, comes on for determination by summary proceedings the Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas filed by Edwin Gayle Farrell, (hereinafter "Applicant").

After considering the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, Richard G. Gannon, Executive Director of the Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"), serving as a presiding officer in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended by L. 1989, Ch. 283, finds as follows:

 That on the 12th day of May, 1989, Applicant filed with the Board an Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. That subsequent to the receipt of the application, Applicant was informed by letter dated May 24, 1989 that the application was considered to be incomplete until such time as Applicant provided the Board with a number of deficiencies as listed in said letter.

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3. That as of this date, Applicant has failed to complete the application by providing the additional information requested.
4. A second letter dated October 11, 1989 was sent to Applicant requesting explanation of the missing requirements on his Application. This letter also remains unanswered.
5. That Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas should be denied due to a lack of a proper response from Applicant to above mentioned letters of May 24, 1989 and October 11, 1989.

6. That the aforementioned reason constitutes sufficient grounds to deny Applicant's application for licensure for failure to satisfy statutory requirements and rules and regulations of the Board pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 65-2833, K.A.R. 100-8-2(e) and K.A.R. 100-6-2(a)(2)(A).

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS: a. That Applicant's Application for Endorsement received in the Board office May 12, 1989 should be denied.

b. That Applicant, pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended, is entitled to request a hearing before the Executive Director of the Board or a presiding officer appointed by him on his Application for Endorsement.

c. That a request by Applicant for a hearing must be made in writing to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 900 S.W. Jackson, Suite 553, Topeka, Kansas 66612, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order on Applicant.

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d. That this Order will become effective if a hearing is not requested as above stated upon the expiration of the time for requesting such a hearing.
