JOURNAL ENTRY ON APPROVAL OF CONSENT ORDER
WITH ADDITIONAL TERMS

On December 14, 2018, the parties appeared before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (Board) for a conference hearing on the approval of the Consent Order in the above captioned matter. Kenneth Fischer, M.D. (Licensee) appeared in person and through counsel, John Hicks. Susan Gering, Deputy Litigation Counsel, appeared on behalf of the Board. The parties submitted a proposed Consent Order, executed by Applicant on October 8, 2018, for the Board's review and approval. Upon review of the proposed consent order, and taking into consideration of the statements and testimony received at the hearing, the Board approved the Consent Order with the following additions as agreed by all parties:

EDUCATION: ETHICS

1. Licensee shall attend and successfully complete the Ethics and Boundaries Exam offered by Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services, L.L.C. ("EBAS") on or before March 29, 2019, unless otherwise approved by the Board.
2. On or before January 31, 2019, Licensee shall notify the Compliance Coordinator in writing of which course date Licensee has registered to attend.
3. Licensee shall provide proof of successful completion of the EBAS exam to the Compliance Coordinator within thirty (30) days of successfully completing the program.
4. All costs associated with such program shall be at Licensee's own expense to include, but not be limited to, the cost of the program, the cost of travel to and from the program, and the cost of accommodations while attending the program.
5. These hours shall be in addition to those continuing education hours required for renewal of licensure.

EDUCATION: MEDICAL RECORD KEEPING

6. Licensee shall attend and successfully complete the "Medical Record Keeping Seminar" put offered by Center for Personalized Education for Professionals (CPEP) on or before March 29, 2019.
7. On or before January 31, 2019, Licensee shall notify the Compliance Coordinator in writing of the date in which he is signed up to take the record keeping course.

8. Licensee shall provide proof of successful completion of the above course(s)/seminar(s) to the Compliance Coordinator within thirty (30) calendar days of successful completion.
9. All costs associated with such program shall be at Licensee's own expense to include, but not be limited to, the cost of the program, the cost of travel to and from the program, and the cost of accommodations while attending the program.
10. These hours shall be in addition to those continuing education hours required for renewal of licensure.

THEREFORE, the Consent Order executed by Licensee on October 8, 2018, and submitted to the Board for review and approval at the December 14, 2018, Board meeting, is hereby **APPROVED** with the agreed **ADDITIONS** ordered herein.


