FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 7th day of August, 1993, this matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the request submitted by William A. Fisher, D.C., (hereafter "Licensee") for reconsideration of the requirement to take the SPEC examination as set forth in the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order executed April 17, 1993. Licensee appeared in person with his attorney of record, Richard D. Anderson of Topeka.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. Licensee was originally licensed to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas on June 6, 1970.

2. On June 30, 1989, Licensee's license expired and Licensee failed to renew said license on or before August 1, 1989. Pursuant to K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2809, Licensee's license was cancelled effective August 1, 1989.

3. On October 1, 1992, Licencee's license was reinstated on exempt status.

4. Pursuant to a request from Licensee to have his license to practice chiropractice in the state of Kansas changed from exempt to active status, a Conference Hearing was held on February 13, 1993.

5. During the conference proceedings of February 13, 1993, disputed issues of material fact regarding Licensee's clinical practice and competency arose.

6. Based upon questions as to Licensee's clinical activities and clinical competency, Licensee's request to convert his license from exempt to active status was denied.

7. In lieu of formal administrative proceedings as required by K.S.A. 77-511 relating to the matter of changing Licensee's license status from exempt to active, the parties entered into a stipulation executed April 17, 1993.

8. In said Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order, Licensee agreed to sit for the SPEC examination which will be administered in September 1993 at the expense of Licensee. Licensee agreed that arrangements for the taking of said SPEC examination shall be the sole responsibility of Licensee.

9. By faxed communication dated June 10, 1993, Licensee requested that the Board waive the requirement that Licensee take the SPEC examination in September 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD as follows:

A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.


B. That Licensee's request for modification of the Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order of April 17, 1993 be denied.

C. This is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order, file a Petition for Reconsideration. A Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
