**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW on this 31st day of October, 1992, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the request of William A. Fisher, D.C. (hereafter "Licensee") for retroactive modification of license status. Licensee appeared in person.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. Licensee was originally licensed to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas on June 6, 1970.

2. On June 30, 1989, Licensee's license expired and Licensee failed to renew said license on or before August 1, 1989.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 1989 Supp. 65-2809, Licensee's license was cancelled effective August 1, 1989.

4. On June 1, 1992 and October 13, 1992, the Board received requests from Licensee that his license be reinstated effective August 1, 1989.

5. Pursuant to Board records, Licensee was mailed appropriate forms to reinstate his license to practice chiropractic in the state on September 24, 1991 and April 6, 1992.

6. On August 15, 1992, Licensee appeared before the Board and presented for the first time an application for reinstatement of his license to practice chiropractic in this state.

7. Licensee's license has been reinstated on exempt status as of October 1, 1992, the date said application was determined to be complete.

8. Licensee failed to submit adequate information to justify retroactive reinstatement of his license back to August 1, 1989, the date of cancellation and said request should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that the request of Licensee for reinstatement of his license to practice chiropractic in the state of Kansas to be retroactively effective from August 1, 1989 should be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
