FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING

NOW, on this 2nd day of December 2011, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the petition of Michael Flanery, D.C. ("Licensee") for termination of the monitoring provisions imposed under the terms of Consent Order filed in Docket No. 11-HA00033. Licensee appears *pro se*. Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order following a conference hearing in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the testimony and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Michael Flanery, D.C. ("Licensee"), is licensed to engage in the practice of chiropractic in the State of Kansas, License No. 01-05358, and has been so licensed since approximately October 8, 2010.


2. On or about September 10, 2010, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted licensure, in order to resolve concerns regarding

4. On or about September 19, 2011, Licensee petitioned the Board to lift the practice monitoring terms imposed upon Licensee by the Consent Order.


5. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and should have no further obligation for compliance.


