ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW on this 17th day of February, 1996, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Gale Marie Fleming (hereafter "Permittee") to grant a third temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 65-2906(b)(3) and more specifically, K.A.R. 100-36-1.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Permittee appears in person *pro se*. Jackie Rawlings appears on behalf of the Physical Therapy Examining Committee.

After hearing statements from the parties and Permittee and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for a third temporary permit was received from Permittee on January 22, 1996.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on February 17, 1996 was filed herein on February 2, 1996 and served on Permittee on that same date.

3. Permittee has applied for permanent registration as a physical therapist assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 65-2906(b)(3).

4. Permittee was granted temporary registration number 9621140, which expired on February 15, 1996.

5. Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1, not more than two temporary permits shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board and for which good cause shall be shown.

5. The Board finds that sufficient cause exists to grant Permittee a third temporary permit for the period of February 17, 1996 to August 31, 1996.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary permit be granted, to expire on August 31, 1996.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a final order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
