ORDER OF DENIAL OF LICENSE

NOW on this 13th day of December, 1989, comes on for determination by summary proceedings the Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas filed by John Thomas Forsythe, (hereinafter "Applicant").

After considering the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, Richard G. Gannon, Executive Director of the Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"), serving as a presiding officer in summary proceedings pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended by L. 1989, Ch. 283, finds as follows:

1. That on the 19th day of May, 1989, Applicant filed with the Board an Application for Endorsement to obtain a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
2. That subsequent to the receipt of the application, Applicant was informed by letter dated June 7, 1989 that the application was considered to be incomplete until such time as Applicant provided the Board with an explanation for each of the eight "yes" answered questions in Sec. VI-Discipline.

3. That as of this date, **Applicant** has failed to complete the application by providing the additional information requested.

4. Applicant's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Oklahoma was suspended for 90 days from February 1, 1988 through **April 30, 1988** and thereafter placed on probation for a period of five years beginning May 1, 1988 under certain terms and conditions.

5. That Applicant's application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas should be denied for the following reasons:

A. The previous suspension and the present probation of **Applicant's** license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Oklahoma is a violation of K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 65-2836(1), with a certified copy of the record of the action of the other jurisdiction being conclusive evidence thereof, and constitutes grounds for denial of **Applicant's** application pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2805.

B. That the previous suspension of Applicant's license by the state of Oklahoma does not entitle Applicant to issuance of an endorsement license pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833.

C. Further, due to a lack of a proper response from Applicant to above mentioned letter of June 7, 1989, **Applicant's** application is incomplete and must be denied.


6. That the aforementioned reasons constitute sufficient grounds to deny **Applicant's** application for licensure.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- a. That **Applicant's** Application for Endorsement received in the Board office May 19, 1989 should be denied.
- b. That Applicant, pursuant to K.S.A. 1988 Supp. 77-511 and 77-537, as amended, is entitled to request a hearing before the Executive Director of the Board or a presiding officer appointed by him on his Application for Endorsement.
- c. That a request by Applicant for a hearing must be made in writing to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 900 S.W. Jackson, Suite 553, Topeka, Kansas 66612, within fifteen (15) days after service of this Order on Applicant.
- d. That this Order will become effective if a hearing is not requested as above stated upon the expiration of the time for requesting such a hearing.




