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**FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE**

NOW on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Pamela Fulmer, L.R.T. (“Applicant”) for a license to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and pro se. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Respiratory Therapy Practice Act, K.S.A. 65-7301, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions, and order:

1. Applicant is seeking licensure by examination. Applicant has been practicing radiology technology in Missouri since 1972. Missouri does not issue either a license or a certificate to radiologic technologists.
2. Applicant attended Independence Sanitarium School of Radiologic Technology and earned her radiologic technology certificate in 1972.
3. The Independence Sanitarium School of Radiologic Technology closed in approximately 1980. At that, time current students were transferred to Avila College, but

transcripts for past students were not retained. As a result, Applicant is unable to provide her transcripts from Independence Sanitarium School of Radiologic Technology.

4. As part of her application, Applicant provided her transcript from Ottawa University, which shows 64 transfer credit hours from Independence Sanitarium School of Radiologic Technology.


5. Applicant also provided duplicate school reports from The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (“ARRT”). These reports show that in January 1973, Applicant passed the examination for radiology. Applicant also produced a letter from the ARRT stating that she qualified for ARRT examination based upon her education and training in the approved educational program at Independence Sanitarium and Hospital.

6. The Board concludes that Applicant has provided sufficient evidence of her education as required by K.S.A. 65-7305.

7. The Board concludes that Applicant’s application for licensure should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Applicant is hereby GRANTED a license by examination to practice radiologic technology in the State of Kansas.
