FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 23RD DAY OF JUNE, 1995, this matter comes on for conference hearing upon the application for Temporary Permit by Sobia Ghazali, M.D. Dr. Ghazali appears in person.

Following formal action of the Board, Aga Kahn University Medical College of Karachi, Pakistan is approved as meeting the standard for approval established by law.

Having the record before it and having heard the presentation of Dr. Ghazali, the Board finds as follows:

Findings of Fact

1. The facts stated in the completed application of Dr. Ghazali are not in dispute.
2. Dr. Ghazali has been appointed to a full-time postgraduate residency program at the University of Kansas Medical Center.
3. Dr. Ghazali graduated and received her medical education from the Aga

Kahn University, located in Karachi, Pakistan. Aga Kahn University has not been in operation for 15 or more years and has not previously been approved by the Board.

4. After reviewing the appropriate information, the Board finds that Aga Kahn University Medical College meets the criteria for approval established by K.A.R. 100-6-3.

Conclusions of Law

5. An application for a temporary permit to practice the healing arts may be granted to a person who has been accepted to a full-time approved postgraduate residency program if the school of the healing arts is either accredited by the Board or has been in operation for not less than 15 years.


6. The Board may approve a school of medicine and surgery if it meets the standards set forth in K.A.R. 110-6-3.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that a temporary permit be issued to Dr. Ghazali, effective June 26, 1995, for the purpose of engaging in residency training at the University of Kansas Medical Center.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Aga Kahn University Medical College of Karachi, Pakistan be placed on the list of accredited healing arts schools.
