CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") by and through Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel ("Petitioner"), and Michelle J. Gillum, P.T. ("Registrant"), and move the Board for approval of a Consent Order affecting Registrant's registration to practice physical therapy in the State of Kansas. The parties stipulate and agree to the following:

1. Registrant's last known mailing address to the Board is 2574 N. Crestline Street, Wichita, Kansas 67205.
2. Registrant is or has been entitled to engage in the practice of physical therapy in the State of Kansas, having been issued Registration No. 11-01094 on March 24, 1984. At all times relevant to the allegations set forth below, Registrant has held a current registration to engage in the practice of physical therapy in the State of Kansas, having last renewed her registration on January 28, 2003.
3. The Board is the sole and exclusive administrative agency in the State of Kansas authorized to regulate the practice of physical therapy. K.S.A. 65-2901 *et seq.*
4. This Consent Order and the filing of such document are in accordance with applicable law and the Board has jurisdiction to enter into the Consent Order as provided

by K.S.A. 77-505. Upon approval, these stipulations shall constitute the findings of the Board, and this Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Final Order.

5. The Kansas Physical Therapy Act is constitutional on its face and as applied in this case.

6. Registrant agrees that, in considering this matter, the Board is not acting beyond its jurisdiction as provided by law.

7. Registrant voluntarily and knowingly waives her right to a hearing. Registrant voluntarily and knowingly waives her right to present a defense by oral testimony and documentary evidence, to submit rebuttal evidence, and to conduct cross-examination of witnesses. Registrant voluntarily and knowingly agrees to waive all possible substantive and procedural motions and defenses that could be raised if an administrative hearing were held.

8. The terms and conditions of the Consent Order are entered into between the undersigned parties and are submitted for the purpose of allowing these terms and conditions to become an Order of the Board. This Consent Order shall not be binding on the Board until an authorized signature is affixed at the end of this document. Registrant specifically acknowledges that counsel for the Board is not authorized to sign this Consent Order on behalf of the Board.

9. On or about February 28, 2000, Registrant was convicted in Sedgwick County of obtaining a prescription by fraud.

10. Registrant called in a prescription for Tussionex and presented to the pharmacy to fill the prescription. The prescription was not authorized by any physician.

11. On or about August 19, 2002, Registrant was convicted in Sedgwick County of petit theft.

12. Registrant filled a prescription for Lortab for a friend and replaced the Lortab with Tylenol.

13. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2912(a)(5), the Board has authority to revoke, suspend, censure or otherwise limit Registrant's registration.

14. According to K.S.A. 77-505 the Board has authority to enter into this Consent Order without the necessity of proceeding to a formal hearing.

15. In lieu of the conclusion of formal proceedings, Registrant, by signature affixed to this Consent Order, hereby voluntarily agrees to the following disciplinary measures placed on her registration to engage in the practice of physical therapy:

16. This Consent Order constitutes disciplinary action.

17. Registrant's failure to comply with the provisions of the Consent Order may result in the Board taking disciplinary action as the Board deems appropriate according to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.

18. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to deny the Board jurisdiction to investigate alleged violations of the Physical Therapy Act, or to investigate complaints received under the Risk Management Law, K.S.A. 65-4921 *et seq.*, that are known or unknown and are not covered under this Consent Order, or to initiate formal proceedings based upon known or unknown allegations of violations of the Physical

Therapy Act.

19. Registrant hereby releases the Board, its individual members (in their official and personal capacities), attorneys, employees and agents, hereinafter collectively referred to as ("Releasees"), from any and all claims, including but not limited to, those alleged damages, actions, liabilities, both administrative and civil, including the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* arising out of the investigation and acts leading to the execution of this Consent Order. This release shall forever discharge the Releasees of any and all claims or demands of every kind and nature that Registrant has claimed to have had at the time of this release or might have had, either known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and Registrant shall not commence to prosecute, cause or permit to be prosecuted, any action or proceeding of any description against the Releasees.

20. Registrant further understands and agrees that upon signature by Registrant, this document shall be deemed a public record, and shall be reported to any reporting entities requiring disclosure of this Consent Order.

21. This Consent Order, when signed by both parties, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may only be modified or amended by a subsequent document executed in the same manner by the parties.

22. Registrant agrees that all information maintained by the Board pertaining to the nature and result of any complaint and/or investigation may be fully disclosed to and considered by the Board in conjunction with the presentation of any offer of settlement, even if Registrant is not present. Registrant further acknowledges that the Board may

conduct further inquiry as it deems necessary before the complete or partial acceptance or rejection of any offer of settlement.

23. Registrant, by signature to this document, waives any objection to the participation of the Board members in the consideration of this offer of settlement and agrees not to seek the disqualification or recusal of any Board member in any future proceeding on the basis that the Board member has received investigative information from any source which otherwise may not be admissible or admitted as evidence.

24. Registrant acknowledges that she has read this Consent Order and fully understands the contents.

25. Registrant acknowledges that this Consent Order has been entered into freely and voluntarily.

26. All correspondence or communication between Registrant and the Board relating to this Consent Order shall be by certified mail addressed to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, Attn: Stacy L. Cook, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, Kansas 66603-3068.

27. Registrant shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice of physical therapy in the State of Kansas that may be in place at the time of execution of the Consent Order or may become effective subsequent to the execution of this document.

28. Upon execution of this Consent Order by affixing a Board authorized signature below, the provisions of this Consent Order shall become an Order. This Consent Order shall constitute the Board's Order when filed with the Office of the

Executive Director for the Board and no further Order is required.

29. The Board may consider all aspects of this Consent Order in any future matter regarding Registrant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Consent Order and agreement of the parties contained herein is adopted by the Board as findings of fact and conclusions of law.
