**FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING**

NOW, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2000, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole in a conference proceeding regarding the application for licensure filed by Stephen Dennis Gipps, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant").

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. Applicant appeared *pro se*.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On May 3, 2000, Applicant filed an application for licensure to obtain a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. Applicant graduated from the University of South Wales which is not an accredited school of medicine.
3. As part of his application, Applicant provided information and documentation regarding his postgraduate training. The information reflected that Applicant has obtained one year of approved postgraduate training in the United States and was a resident medical officer for one year following his graduation from medical school.
4. Applicant does not meet the requirements for licensure under K.S.A. 65-2873.

5. Applicant has an active license to practice in the state of Oregon.

6. Applicant has met all of the requirements of K.S.A. 65-2833 and is eligible for a license under that statute.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:


1. That the findings here and above made be and the same are the order of the Board.


