ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 19th day of June, 1989, this matter comes before the Board as a result of a Stipulation having been entered into between the Board and the above-named Licensee.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts is represented by its Disciplinary Counsel, Joseph M. Furjanic. There are no other appearances.

After examining the files, hearing the statements of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

a. That, Licensee's current license will come up for renewal August 1, 1989.

b. That, Licensee has no intention to resume practice of medicine and surgery in Kansas.

c. That, Licensee hereby surrenders his certificate to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas effective with the date that this Stipulation is accepted by the Board.

d. That, Licensee acknowledges that this Stipulation may be provided to the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, Inc.


e. That, this Stipulation in no way can be construed as an admission of any violation of the Healing Arts Act by Licensee, which violations are expressly denied.

f. That, should Licensee apply for reinstatement of this license, this Stipulation shall in no way preclude the Board from utilizing the information previously gathered in determining whether or not Licensee should be reinstated.

g. That, the Board agrees that it has accepted the Licensee's surrender of license and it will not open any formal proceedings against Licensee on the condition that Licensee waives his procedural rights to due process and hearing under the Administrative Procedure Act with respect to the matters agreed to herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board that the findings hereinabove made be and the same are hereby made the order of the Board, the Stipulation attached hereto is hereby approved and Licensee is ordered and directed to comply with all provisions thereof.

STIPULATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this ^{16th}~~14th~~ day of June, 1989, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and VINSON WAYNE GLEASON, D.O., (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

1. The Licensee holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas No. 12049.

2. Prior to August 1, 1989 Licensee closed his office in Hutchinson, Kansas and maintains his personal residence in the state of Arizona and has moved there permanently and has no desire or intention to return to the state of Kansas to practice medicine.

3. Immediately prior to Licensee's closure of his office in Kansas he met on an informal basis with the staff of the Board of Healing Arts and they informed him of concerns that had been raised about his practice. Licensee denies that he has violated any provisions of the Healing Arts Act and is prepared to offer additional information in support of the treatment he has provided to the patients.

4. Nevertheless, in order to avoid further expense and consumption of time upon behalf of either the Board or Licensee, he stipulates as follows with the Board:

a. His current license will come up for renewal August 1, 1989;

b. That he has no intention to resume practice of medicine and surgery in Kansas;

c. The Licensee hereby surrenders his certificate to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas effective with the date that this Stipulation is accepted by the Board;

d. Licensee acknowledges that this Stipulation may be provided to the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, Inc.


e. That this Stipulation in no way can be construed as an admission of any violation of the Healing Arts Act by Licensee, which violations are expressly denied.

f. That should Licensee apply for reinstatement of this license this Stipulation shall in no way preclude the Board from utilizing the information previously gathered in determining whether or not he should be reinstated.

5. The Board agrees that it has accepted the Licensee's surrender of license and it will not open any formal proceeding against Licensee on the condition that Licensee waives his procedural rights to due process and hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act with respect to the matters agreed to herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Stipulation on the date indicated below their signature, it being specifically and expressly understood that the Stipulation and surrender of Licensee's license shall not become effective until such time as it has been approved by the Board at a public meeting thereof and the Board has issued an Enforcement Order based upon such Stipulation.
