AMENDED FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 8th day of October, 2005, this matter comes before the Board upon a motion by Richard M. Glover II, M.D. to terminate the limitations on his license. Dr. Glover appears in person and through Steve A. Schwarm, Attorney at Law. Kelli J. Stevens, Litigation Counsel appears for the Board.

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The Board issued a Final Order dated July 9, 2001 imposing limitations upon the license of Dr. Glover. Those limitations included a prohibition against the practice of obstetrics, and required consultation with a cardiologist or internal medicine specialist when treating acute cardiac disease.
2. Following the Final Order, Dr. Glover completed an assessment at the Colorado Physician's Evaluation Program. Based upon that assessment, Dr. Glover engaged in and successfully completed the education program recommended by CPEP.
3. There is good cause to believe that Dr. Glover is professionally competent to treat acute cardiac disease without consultation with another physician as required by the 2001 Final Order.

4. Dr. Glover has not practiced obstetrics since the 2001 Final Order, does not have hospital privileges to engage in that practice, and has no present intent to engage in that practice. Dr. Glover agrees to notify the Board's counsel upon application for obstetrics privileges in any hospital. This agreement does not constitute a limitation on his license.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the limitations upon the license of Richard M. Glover II imposed by the July 9, 2001 Final Order are hereby terminated.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
