NOW, on this the 9th day of October, 2006, this matter comes

before the Presiding Officer, John White, D.O. Iris Gonzalez, M.D., Licensee, appears through Michael Francis, Attorney at Law. Kelli Stevens, Litigation Counsel and Kathleen Selzler Lippert, Associate Counsel appear for the Board.

Having the agency record before it and upon hearing the statements of counsel, the Presiding Officer finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The proceedings in Docket No. 06-HA-00087 and Docket No. 07-HA-00007 involve the same parties and subject matter. As such, the two actions are hereby consolidated under the later action, Docket No. 07-HA-00007. All pleadings shall hereafter be filed under that docket number.

2. In the Final Order issued August 12, 2006, in Docket No. 07-HA-00007, Licensee was granted an extension of time to September 10, 2006, to complete a continuing education course in appropriate prescribing of controlled substances. The University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (UMDNJ) Mini Residency in Appropriate Prescribing DVD Program was approved as an acceptable course.

3. The Final Order limited Licensee from prescribing, dispensing or administering any controlled substance (Confidential)

6. On September 8, 2006, Licensee completed the UMDNJ Mini Residency in Appropriate Prescribing DVD Program and passed the examination portion (Confidential)

The Presiding Officer orders that based on the findings and recommendations (Confidential) and Licensee's successful completion of and examination in the UMDNJ Mini Residency in Appropriate Prescribing DVD program, the limitation on Licensee's license prohibiting her from prescribing, dispensing or administering any controlled substance is hereby terminated.

9. The Presiding Officer further orders that the remaining requirements for monitoring, record-keeping and education contained in the Consent Order Licensee entered into with the Board on April 10, 2006, remain in effect.


10. Karen Bruce, M.D. has been approved as monitor to review patient records as provided by the April 10, 2006 Consent Order.

Those documents shall not be redisclosed except as necessary to conduct further proceedings in this matter or as otherwise authorized by the Board.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


