FINAL ORDER

Now on this 8th day of December 2007, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the Licensee’s request to terminate monitoring of her prescribing of controlled substances. Licensee appears in person *pro se*. Kathleen Selzler Lippert appears as counsel for the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Licensee agreed to a Consent Order that was approved by the Board and subsequently filed on April 10, 2006.
2. In the Consent Order, Licensee agreed to a limitation on her license in that her prescribing of controlled substances would be monitored for at least one (1) year.
3. Licensee has completed one (1) year of monitoring of her controlled substance prescribing. During the course of monitoring, Licensee has demonstrated improvement in her documentation, counseling **(Confidential)**
4. Licensee also agreed to the terms set forth in the Agreed Journal Entry and Order filed on October 9, 2006.

7. During the conference hearing, Licensee agreed to additional monitoring of her patient charts. During the next year, her monitor, Karen Bruce, M.D., shall conduct a random audit of five to ten patient charts and submit a written report to the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED that the limitation placed on Licensee's license regarding prescribing controlled substances as described in the Consent Order filed on April 10, 2006 is hereby terminated.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee shall have five to ten patient charts randomly audited during the next year and shall cause her monitor, Karen Bruce, M.D., to submit a written report to the Board.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final

Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.


