**JOURNAL ENTRY GRANTING
MOTION TO TERMINATE CONSENT ORDER**

On February 11, 2022, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) conducted a video conference hearing on Petitioner’s Motion to Terminate Consent Order (“Motion”). Matthew Gaus, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared in person as counsel for the disciplinary panel of the Board (“Petitioner”). Iris P. Gonzalez, M.D. (“Dr. Gonzalez”) appeared *pro se* and participated by video.

1. On or about April 10, 2020, the parties entered into a Consent Order placing limits on the license of Dr. Gonzalez for a period of at least one year and requiring Dr. Gonzalez to successfully complete educational requirements on prescribing controlled drugs.
2. On or about November 16, 2021, Dr. Gonzalez emailed Board staff and requested termination of the Consent Order.
3. On or about December 23, 2021, counsel for the disciplinary panel filed the Motion. The Motion requested: (1) the Board determine whether Dr. Gonzalez had successfully completed the requirements of the Consent Order; and (2) if the Board finds that the requirements of the Consent Order have been successfully completed by Dr. Gonzalez – that the Consent Order be terminated.

4. Upon review of the Motion, the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and testimony received at the hearing, the Board finds Dr. Gonzalez has successfully completed the requirements of the Consent Order and grants the Motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, the Motion to Terminate Consent Order is **GRANTED**, and Consent Order is **TERMINATED**.


