ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW on this 14th day of October, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board at the request of Tracy L. Goodsen (hereinafter "Registrant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5508(e).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). Registrant appears in person *pro se*. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact , conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for second temporary registration was received from Tracy Goodsen on September 22, 1995.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 8:45 a.m. on October 14, 1995 was filed herein on September 29, 1995 and served on Registrant on that same date.

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3. Registrant has applied for permanent registration as a respiratory therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5506(a)(3).

4. Registrant was granted temporary registration number 9501482, which expires November 23, 1995.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5508(e), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a second temporary registration until results from the NBRC examination to be administered in November of 1995 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to registrant until the Board receives the results from the NBRC examination to be administered in November, 1995.

B. That in the event Registrant fails to pass the NBRC examination to be administered in November, 1995, the second temporary registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following the date the failure of said exam becomes available to the Board.

C. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
