JOURNAL ENTRY

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon consideration of the file, applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. John P. Gorecki, M.D. (“Licensee”) has, since approximately February 10, 2001, maintained License No. 04-29019 to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

2. The Board record reflects Licensee’s mailing address of record as confidential Court, Gainesville, Georgia 30504.

3. On December 29, 2009, Executive Director Selzler Lippert, in accordance with K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-514(g), filed a Summary Order against Licensee for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* The Summary Order ordered the public censure of Licensee, and required Licensee to pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00. Payment of the fine was due to the Board within thirty (30) days following the effective date of the Order.

4. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-531, the Summary Order was sent to Licensee, on December 29, 2009, by mailing a copy of the Summary Order to Licensee at Licensee’s last

known address of record, via United States Mail, first-class postage prepaid.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-542, the Summary Order notified Licensee that if a written request for hearing was not filed within 15 days following service of the Summary Order, the Summary Order would become effective as a Final Order upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.

6. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-526 and 77-530, the Summary Order became effective as a Final Order on January 18, 2010.

7. On January 21, 2010, Licensee filed a “Request for Hearing & Alternatively Motion for Reconsideration and for Extension.”

8. On February 24, 2010, Executive Director Selzler Lippert filed a Journal Entry granting Licensee’s Motion for Continuance. The Board record reflects that a copy of the Journal Entry was sent to Licensee’s Attorney of record with the Board.

9. On April 28, 2010, Executive Director Selzler Lippert, in accordance with K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-514(g), filed a Final Order against Licensee for violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* The Final Order denied Licensee’s motion for reconsideration of the Summary Order filed in the matter, and upheld the findings and order in the Summary Order.

10. The Board record reflects that, on April 28, 2010, a copy of the Final Order was sent to Licensee at Licensee’s last known address of record, via United States Mail, first-class postage prepaid, and to Licensee’s attorney of record with the Board.

11. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-531, service of a Final Order by mail is complete upon mailing.

12. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-530, the Final Order was effective upon service.

13. The Final Order notified Licensee that, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-613, Licensee could seek judicial review of the Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court within 30 days following service of the Final Order.

14. As of the date of filing of this Journal Entry, Licensee has not filed a petition for judicial review of the Final Order in this matter.

15. The Board record reflects that, on or about May 18, 2010, Licensee satisfied the provision of the Final Order requiring payment of the fine in the amount of \$1,000.00.

16. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Final Order and has no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee has satisfied all terms and conditions of the Final Order, and that the violations set forth in the Final Order shall be deemed resolved without entry of further order.


