**ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION**

NOW, on this 29th day of April, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of **TERRY L. GOURLEY**, (hereafter "Registrant") to grant a second temporary registration to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Mr. Gourley appeared pro se.

After hearing statements from the Licensing Administrator and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1) A request for a second temporary registration was received from Terry L. Gourley on January 25, 1995.

2) Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:15 a.m. on April 29, 1995 was filed herein on April 13, 1995 and mailed to Registrant on that same date.

3) Registrant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).

4) Registrant was granted a temporary registration number, 9500394, which expired on February 15, 1995 and was administratively extended to May 15, 1995 to enable the Board to consider Registrant's request for a second temporary registration.

5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a second temporary registration which shall be valid until the occurrence of any one of the following:

(a) Registrant, prior to December 15, 1995, provides proof of successful passage of the NCCPA examination to be administered October, 1995, then the temporary registration will be cancelled on the date the Board issues a permanent registration to Registrant;

(b) Registrant, prior to December 15, 1995, fails to provide proof of passage of the October, 1995 NCCPA examination, then the temporary registration will be cancelled and of no further force or effect.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

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**ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION**

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Registrant which will be valid until cancelled as provided in paragraph 6 above.

b. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
