FINAL ORDER

NOW this February 19, 2010 the above captioned matter comes before the Board on the petitioner's application for Reinstatement of his License to Practice Medicine and Surgery. The petitioner appears in person. The Board appears by and through Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel. There are no other appearances. The petitioner was sworn as a witness. After hearing the statements of counsel and of the petitioner, having reviewed the file and being generally apprised of the premises, the Board finds and concludes as follows:

1. The petitioner was originally issued a Kansas license on August 17, 2002.
2. The petitioner's license was cancelled by request on June 30, 2003. The petitioner has not been licensed in Kansas since that date.
3. The petitioner has been the subject of disciplinary activity in Texas, Florida and New York.
4. The petitioner currently has active unencumbered licenses in New York, Missouri, Illinois, Indiana and Mississippi. The petitioner holds inactive licenses in Virginia, New Jersey, North Carolina, Florida, Wisconsin, Connecticut, Iowa and Texas.

WHEREUPON, it was moved by Dr. Hodges and seconded by Dr. the petitioner be granted a license to practice medicine and surgery.

WHEREUPON, a vote upon the MOTION was held, the majority of those voting were in favor of GRANTING the petitioner a license to practice medicine and surgery. Board members Ice and Sharpe vote NO to the MOTION.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner's Application for a License to Practice Medicine and Surgery is hereby GRANTED.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. 
