FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 9th day of December, 1994, this matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") sitting as a whole as presiding officer in a conference proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 77-533 through 77-535, the request submitted by Gary R. Griffin (hereafter "Applicant") for waiver of Section 17 entitled "Certification of RT School" on the Application for Registration in Respiratory Therapy in the State of Kansas.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appeared before the Board to present information. Applicant did not appear.

After reviewing the application and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On September 16, 1994, Applicant filed an Application for Registration in Respiratory Therapy in the State of Kansas.

2. As part of that application, Applicant indicated that Section 17 of the application entitled "Certification of RT School" had not been completed since he had received his credentials under the grandfather clause of the N.B.R.C.

3. Although Applicant did not attend and complete a formal training program in respiratory therapy, he currently holds an active and valid registration in the State of Texas.

4. The information provided by Applicant in support of his application is in substantial conformity with the requirements of K.S.A. 65-5508(b).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a) That the findings here and above made be in the same and are made the Order of the Board.

b) Applicant has provided the information in substantial conformity with K.S.A. 65-5508(b) and he is entitled to registration.

c) That prior to the Board taking action on Applicant's registration at its meeting on February 11, 1995, Applicant will receive a temporary registration under the provision of K.S.A. 65-5508(e) as Applicant has submitted to the Board the appropriate fee for such temporary registration on September 16, 1994.

c) Either party is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if a written request is received in the Board office within five days of service of this Order upon the parties.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
