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SUMMARY ORDER

NOW, on this 12th day of June, 1992, comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole as Presiding Officer in a summary proceeding pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 77-538, the request submitted by Carol Bergquist, M.D. for the issuance of a post-graduate training permit to Clarice L. Grimes, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for the period March 1, 1992 through March 31, 1992. Applicant did not appear.

After reviewing the request and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On October 8, 1991, the Board received Applicant's application for a post-graduate training program temporary permit to engage in a post-graduate training program beginning March 1, 1992 in the Department of General Surgery at the University of Kansas Medical Center at Kansas City, Kansas through March 31, 1992.
- 2. On or about October 9, 1991, the then Licensing Supervisor for the Board by memo to Shirley Walker, Administrative

Assistant at the University of Kansas School of Medicine, apprised Ms. Walker that the application of Applicant was incomplete since a certified copy of medical school diploma had not been provided as part of the application.

- 3. Applicant completed the one-month surgical post-graduate training program under the belief that all necessary requirements for obtaining the post-graduate training program temporary permit had been met and said permit had been issued.
- 4. That upon realizing that said temporary permit had not been issued prior to engaging in the post-graduate training, attempts were made to provide a certified copy of the medical school diploma issued to Applicant and it was discovered that Texas A&M University School of Medicine does not maintain nor provide certified copies of diplomas.
- 5. The Board has subsequently received an official transcript of Applicant verifying her graduation from Texas A&M University School Health Science Center and her receipt of the degree of Doctor of Medicine conferred June 3, 1989.
- 6. That at the time Applicant participated in post-graduate training in the Department of Surgery from March 1, 1992 through March 31, 1992, Applicant had met all the requirements for the issuance of a temporary post-graduate training permit for post-graduate training pursuant to K.S.A. 1991 Supp. 65-2811(a)(1) but that solely due to inadvertence, mistake or misunderstanding, proof of completion of all of the requirements for said permit had not

been provided to the Board prior to Applicant engaging in the postgraduate training program.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- A. That the findings here and above made be and the same are made the Order of the Board.
- B. That a temporary permit for the purposes of engaging in post-graduate training at the University of Kansas Medical Center at Kansas City, Kansas should be forthwith issued to be retroactive for the period March 1, 1992 through March 31, 1992.
- C. Applicant is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if a written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of the service of this Order upon Applicant.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
