FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 17th day of August 2012, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Chakshu Gupta, M.D. (“Applicant”) for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.*, and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about February 13, 2012, Applicant submitted an application for licensure by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was deemed complete and filed with the Board on or about July 27, 2012.

2. In December of 1997, Applicant graduated from medical school at the University of Delhi India, and has been unable to obtain official verification of his medical school education directly from the University to submit with his application. Applicant was able to provide copies of his medical school documentation obtained from his employer.

3. Applicant passed all 3 steps of the USMLE between 1997 and 2003 as required by K.S.A. 65-2873.

4. Applicant completed one (1) year of Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training program with the American Red Cross Blood Service in Kentucky in June of 2000. Applicant then completed a 4 year ACGME accredited residency program in Anatomic and Clinical Pathology at St. John Hospital, affiliated with Wayne State University in Michigan on June 30, 2004. Finally, Applicant participated in an ACGME accredited fellowship at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan in Cytopathology from July 1, 2004 to January 31, 2005.

5. Applicant is currently licensed to practice medicine in the State of Missouri, having been licensed by reciprocity in 2004. There are no reported disciplinary actions against Applicant's Missouri license.

6. Applicant previously held an unrestricted medical license in the State of Michigan from 2003 to 2005, obtained by examination. There were no reported disciplinary actions against Applicant's Michigan license.

7. Applicant received his Education Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification in September 1998.


8. Applicant intends to practice as a pathologist in certain Kansas hospitals which his employer maintains a contract with to provide such services.

9. The Board finds that Applicant has provided satisfactory proof of his medical school education.

10. The Board finds that Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby granted a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
