

3. That pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2811(a)(3) a permit issued under said section "shall be valid for a period of one year following the date of issuance." Further, no more than one temporary permit under said section can be issued to any one person.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the request for extension of the temporary permit from and after August 17, 1993 be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
